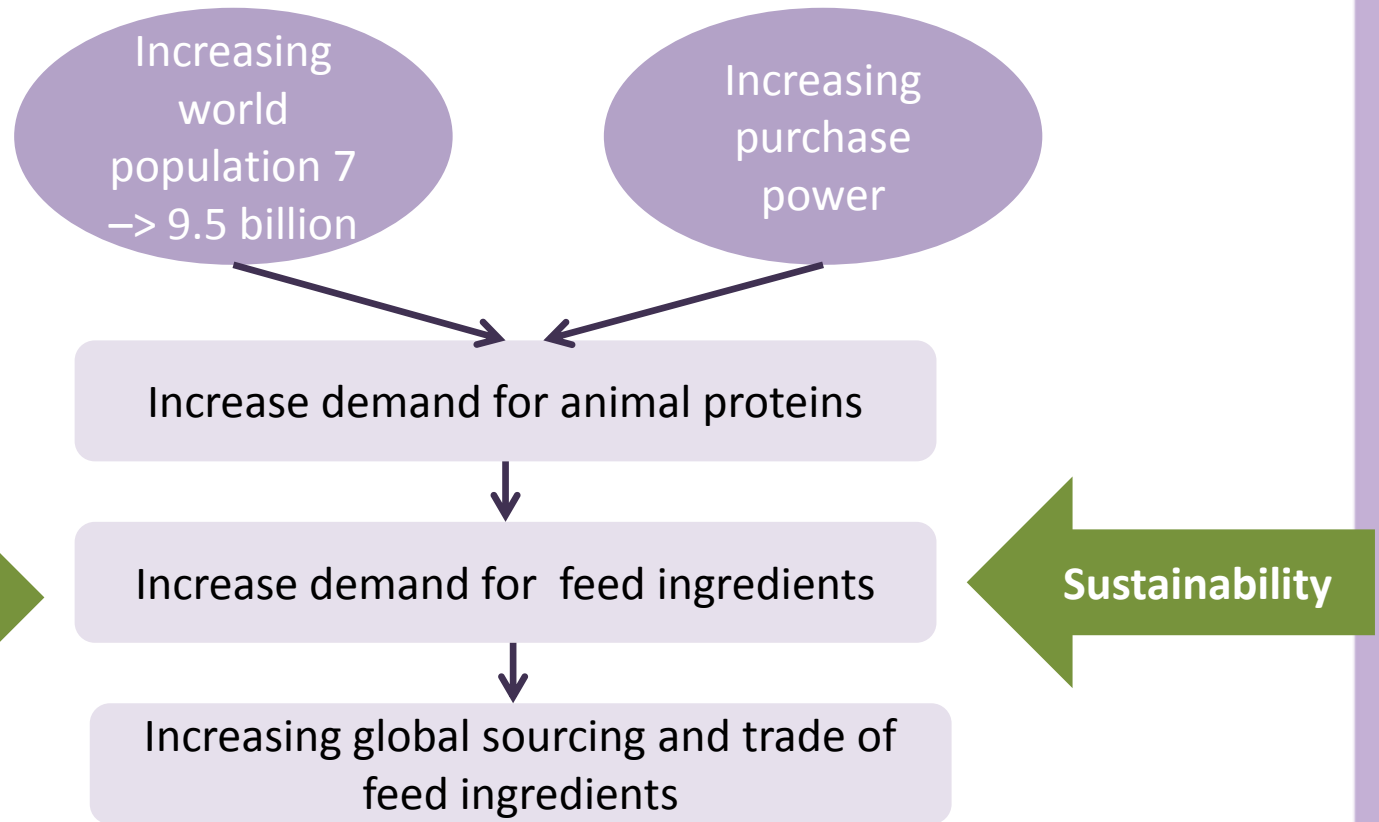

- The management of the international GMP+ Feed **Safety** Assurance (GMP+ FSA) scheme
- Support of companies as source of information regarding feed safety issues:
 - GMP+ Feed Safety Database
 - GMP+ Academy
- **New development: extension to sustainability: responsible soy, renewable energy directive (sustainable biomass),**



GMP+ International

Important objectives (1):

- Managing an *internationally applicable* chain-oriented feed safety & sustainability assurance scheme
- Full space for specific *national* needs via additional country notes

Uniformity as much as possible internationally
Flexibility on national level, if desirable

Important objectives (2):



- Independency by well-balanced *multi-stakeholders' participation* in *International Expert Committee*
- *Support* by, *involvement* and *engagement* of stakeholders via *partnership*

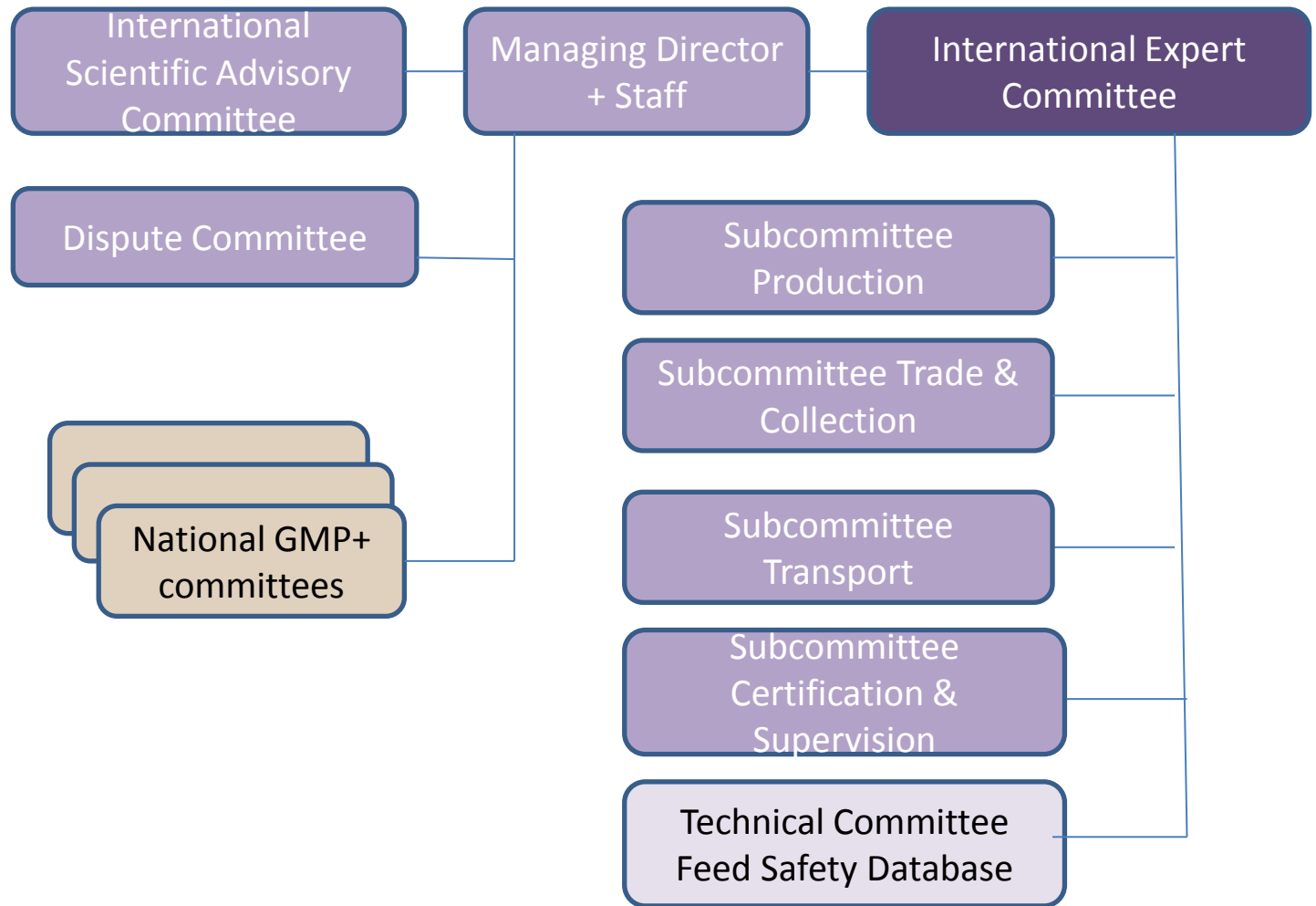

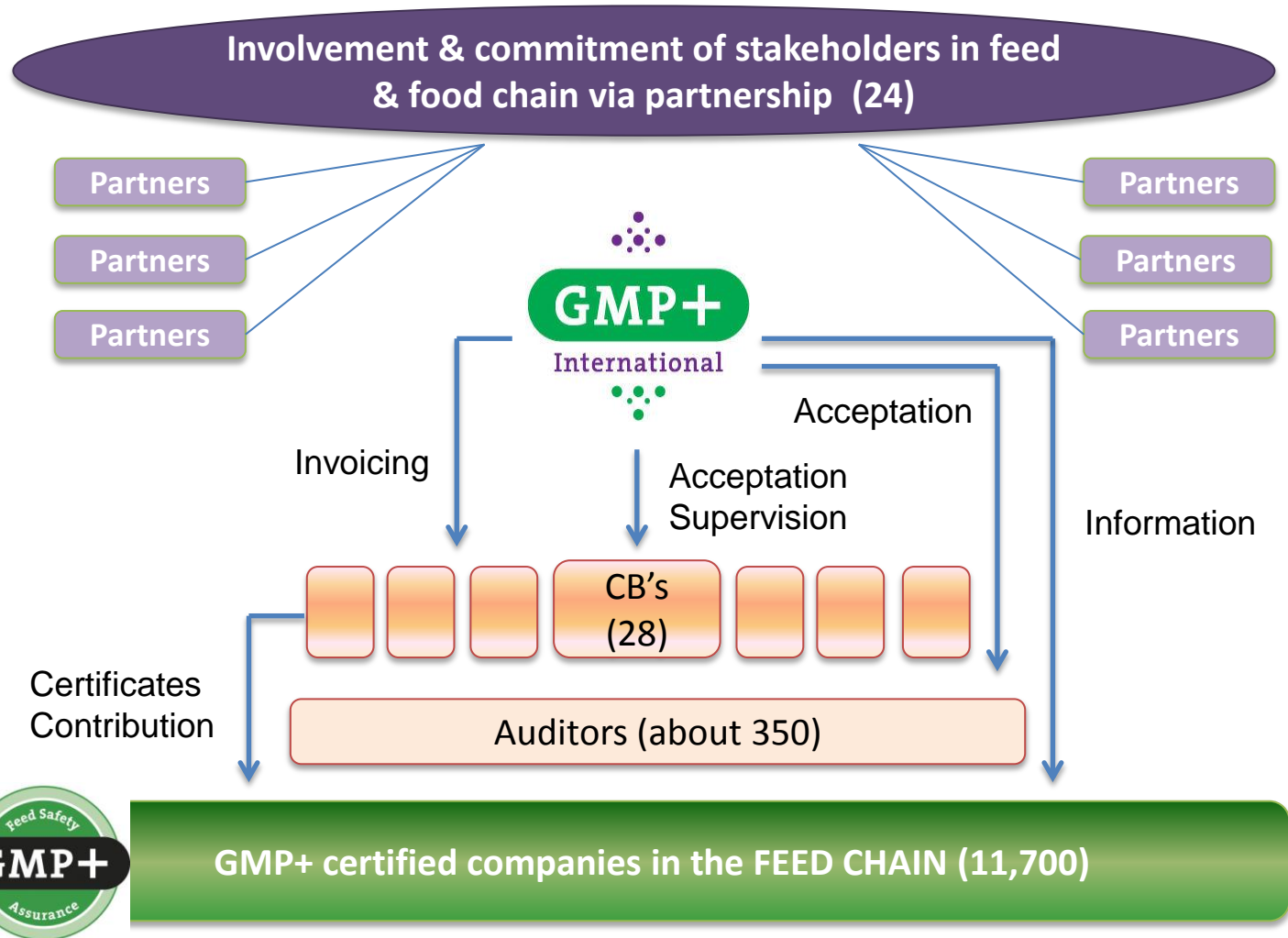
