

## Knowledge of quality of raw materials

### **Description**

In the compound feed industry a large range of feed materials is used. What are the criteria for a certain raw material being used or not, what are the risks, characteristics and applications of raw materials? How are raw materials created and what effect does the creation process have on quality, safety and use?

The number of raw materials is so large that this course is given over several days. For this reason the course has been divided into 4 modules. It is possible to attend less than 4 modules. The participation certificate shows which modules have been attended.

The following subjects are dealt with:

- characteristics of the raw material
- hazards per raw material
- applications

### **Learning objective**

Acquiring an insight into the characteristics, risks and applications of the principal compound feed raw materials in the sector.

### **Target group**

Starting purchasers, nutritionists, internal and external sales employees and quality officers who (will) have to deal with raw materials for compound feed.

### **Language**

This course will be given in Dutch and/or English

### **Dates and locations**

This training consists of 4 modules of half a day each:

- 1) Grains and their by-products
- 2) Oilseeds and their by-products
- 3) Legumes, roots and their by-products
- 4) Minerals, animal by-products, dairy products

Participants may indicate specifically desired raw materials in advance. This will be taken into account as much as possible in the set-up of the course.
